- Applications for admission to the Criminology and Criminal Justice at URI are reviewed only once each year, usually on or about March 1st. Students must apply by the end of February by submitting their names to the University College advisor for sociology or the Chairperson of the Department of Sociology and Anthropology.
- To be considered for admission to the Criminology and Criminal Justice BS program, students must have earned a minimum of 45 credits, including SOC 100, SOC 230, and SOC 274 by the application deadline. Additionally, students must have earned an overall quality point average of 3.0 (pending approval by the Faculty Senate).
