❖ MEET WITH AN ADVISOR —

- discuss your immediate and long-term educational goals
- choose your courses
- plan early for the possibility of transfer
- ask questions and get answers!

❖ USE THE TRANSFER GUIDE FOR STUDENTS (WWW.RIBGHE.ORG/TRANSFERGUIDE.HTM) -

- choose general education courses (Section 1)
- check the transferability of courses (Section 2)
- follow a program transfer plan to a CCRI, RIC or URI degree (Section 3)
- track courses you have taken and courses you need on the planning sheet (last page)
- consider the benefits of the Joint Admissions Agreement (Section 5)

❖ CHOOSE COURSES THAT WILL HELP MEET YOUR GOALS AT BOTH THE COLLEGE YOU ARE ATTENDING AND THE COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY WHERE YOU ARE LIKELY TO TRANSFER -

- meet general education requirements
- fulfill the writing and math requirements
- meet pre-requisites for upper-level courses

❖ TALK TO THE CAREER SERVICES OFFICES ABOUT THE MAJOR AND DEGREE YOU NEED FOR THE CAREER YOU WANT.

❖ USE THE RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO YOU AT CCRI, RIC OR URI -

- become involved with your program or department to get the latest information on your field, including information that will help you to transfer
- contact the admissions offices of the college or university where you are transferring
- plan on attending transfer orientation and advising days
- speak with advisors or faculty at the college or university where you are transferring

❖ EXPLORE COURSES AT CCRI, RIC OR URI

- As a matriculated CCRI, RIC or URI student, you can take up to 7 credit hours of your full-time schedule per semester at one of the other public colleges or university at no extra cost.
